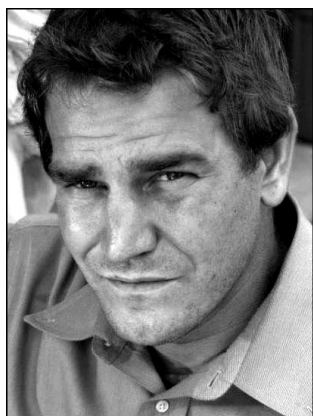


"Sharing my story helps me feel the struggle was not in vain, that I can help others. Even if I help one person, then it's worth it."
