

Sharp Mesa Vista Hospital is located at 7850 Vista Hill Avenue in the heart of Kearny Mesa, south of the intersection of Highway 163 and Interstate 805, a few blocks beyond the end of Genesee Avenue.

- If you're taking Highway 163 North, exit at Genesee Avenue East and turn left onto Health Center Drive, then right onto Vista Hill Avenue. Go about 400 feet and finally turn left into the parking lot of Sharp Mesa Vista Hospital.
- If you're taking Highway 163 South, exit at Genesee Avenue and turn left at the first light, which is at the end of the off ramp. This puts you onto Genesee Avenue going east. Follow Genesee under the bridge and turn left onto Health Center Drive, then right onto Vista Hill Avenue. Go about 400 feet and finally turn left into the parking lot of Sharp Mesa Vista Hospital.
